

Club Entrance Policy

The following rules apply to ALL members of the Auckland Deaf Society (Hereinafter referred to as 'ADS' or 'Club') attending on Friday nights.

1. Members

- 1.1 Admission to the Club is by way of financial members.
- 1.2 In general, the door opens at 7.30pm and closes at around 11pm at Bar Manager's discretion. Opening times are at ADS's discretion.
- 1.3 Membership cards are to be swiped, or manually entered into the system to enter the Clubroom as well entering the Club Raffles.
- 1.4 The Board Members will be on roster weekly for 'Doorperson' to ensure there is no trouble within the ADS Clubroom.
- 1.5 Bringing food and drinks (both alcoholic & non-alcoholic) into Clubroom is prohibited.
- 1.6 Parents with children will be encouraged to leave the Clubroom after speeches and jackpot results have been announced. Parents will be responsible for their children at all times.
- 1.7 A reasonable standard of dress is required at all times. Under no circumstances are Work Boots, Football Gear, gang-affiliated clothing/colours, or untidy clothing to be worn in the Clubroom.
- 1.8 A personal standard of hygiene should be maintained at all times.
- 1.9 Doorperson or Events Coordinator has the right to ask members or visitors to tidy themselves up.

2. Guests, Visitors & Non-Members

- 2.1 Members are responsible for visitors during their visit to the Club. Visitors must sign the Visitors Book.
- 2.2 Non-members, and visitors are allowed into the Clubroom on a \$5 entry fee, which is payable upon entrance.
- 2.3 Guests of ADS (including their interpreters) are exempt from this fee.
- 2.4 The President at his own discretion can issue a special entry permit to International Visitors and they can enter the Clubroom free of charge.

2.5 Visitors are to adhere to all ADS policies, and Members Code of Conduct.

3. Behaviour at the Clubrooms

3.1 Behaviour of all members is to be of a high standard at all times.

3.2 Members will be responsible for their guests' behaviour.

3.3 The sale of alcoholic liquor to persons under the age of 18 is prohibited and identification cards (IDs) must be carried at all times.

3.4 Members are asked to remain courteous to bar and kitchen staff at all times. As ADS is a Club not a pub, we ask that all members return all empty bottles, jugs and glassware to the bar.

3.5 The taking of alcohol outside the Clubroom and off the property is prohibited.

3.6 Intoxicated people will be monitored by bar staff so for your own benefit don't get carried away with your drinking when it affects good judgement and behaviour.

3.7 Disorderly behaviour, obscene or abusive language, drunkenness, sexual harassment and any deliberate breach of provisions in the Club rules or failure to acknowledge proper and responsible exercise of authority or any abuse thereof despite cautioning, shall be considered offences liable to fine. Suspension or expulsion will follow the upholding of any complaint laid with the Board.

3.8 Drugs are not permitted anywhere on the ADS premises. Anyone who is suspected of taking or under the influence of drugs, the Duty/Bar Manager reserves the right under Misuse of Drugs Amendment Act 2005 to have the person in question evicted from the building.

4. Miscellaneous

4.1 Members are expected to respect Club property and premises at all times and report any vandalism to the Manager. We ask that member's keep the Clubroom clean and tidy at all times and treat it with the respect that it deserves.

4.2 There is to be no speeding in the parking areas. Park in the car parks provided. Do not park on the grass adjacent to the Clubroom.

4.3 Your Hearing Dog should always be under your supervision at all times. Refer to *Hearing Dogs for the Deaf Policy* for more information.
